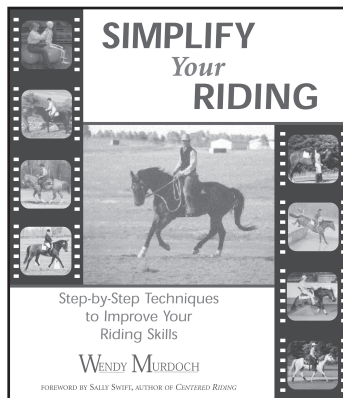




About Wendy Murdoch

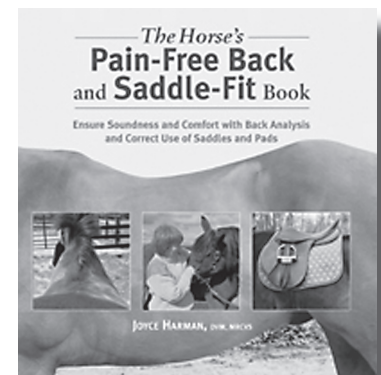

About Dr. Harman

Dr. Joyce Harman graduated from Virginia Maryland Regional College of Veterinary Medicine in 1984 with an interest in acupuncture and alternative medicine, even though it was not taught at the veterinary school. She then went to England to study equine exercise physiology and sports medicine and Ireland to work in a veterinary practice, complete with a surgery, that treated mostly race-horses. Afterward, she went to Switzerland to study the effects of training polo ponies at a high altitude.

Dr. Harman became a Certified Veterinary Acupuncturist in 1990. In 1994 she became a Certified Veterinary Chiropractor and also completed advanced homeopathic and herbal training. A masters degree in Chinese medicine is in progress.

Harmany Equine Clinic, Ltd., is a totally holistic clinic where Joyce Harman uses mostly acupuncture, chiropractic, homeopathy, nutrition and herbs to help horses realize their potential, whether they are western pleasure horses, Olympic level athletes, Grand Prix dressage horses or novice event horses.

Joyce's interest in saddle fitting led her to become the first veterinarian to acquire a computerized saddle-fitting device. This technology brings science and technology to an area of the horse industry previously served by manufacturers with little knowledge or interest in fitting horses, or in quality control. The equipment provides a color image of the saddle pressure and contact points.

Dr. Harman writes extensively in both the lay and professional magazines and also speaks to both groups frequently. She has just finished a complete book on saddle fitting, *The Pain Free Back and Saddle Fit Book*.
